1- Data controller / Contact

The present policy of confidentiality has for vocation to help you to understand how your personal data are collected, treated and preserved by MTI INTERNATIONAL (hereafter "MTI INTERNATIONAL", "us", "our" and "our"), person in charge for the treatment in the direction of the European regulation as regards protection of the data in personal matter, company MTI INTERNATIONAL, limited liability company with the capital of 37 120€ registered under the SIREN number 409611696, whose registered office is located at the 9 route de Clermont - 43 100 Cohade

2- When are your personal data collected?

We receive and process information, which may include personal data, about you when you access and use our site in a number of ways:

4- Personal data recipients

In our capacity as data controller, we will be the first recipients of your personal data. Your data will be more specifically treated by the following staff within MTI INTERNATIONAL:*** data processing?

We may also share your personal data with third parties in the following situations:

- Your personal data may be communicated to the police authorities (upon judicial requisition) or to any person legally entitled to receive such information (upon a court order).

5- How will your personal data be hosted?

We take care to secure personal data in an adequate and appropriate manner and have taken the necessary precautions to preserve and have our hosting subcontractors preserve the security and confidentiality of the data and in particular to prevent it from being distorted, damaged or communicated to unauthorized persons.

Your data are hosted on the European servers located in Ireland of WIX.com LTD, whose head office is located at 40 Namal Tel Aviv, 6350671, ISRAEL.

All personal data collected is hosted in Europe or in countries recognized by the European Commission as having adequate protection for personal data.

6- Retention period of personal data processing

All personal data will be destroyed immediately upon deletion of the user's account.

Your personal data will also be destroyed if you have not logged into your user account for a period of more than six (6) months.

It will then be archived on separate databases to meet our legal obligations for a period not exceeding five (5) years from the date of archiving.

7- Legal right exercise

In accordance with the European regulation on the protection of personal data, you have the following rights:

- A right of access allowing you at any time to know if your personal data are or are not processed by our services and when they are, to have access to the said personal data and to the information required by law concerning the methods of processing these data,
- A right of rectification allowing you to request that any inaccuracies concerning your personal data be corrected as soon as possible.

- A right to erasure, allowing you to request as soon as possible that your personal data be erased, provided that such request for erasure complies with the conditions required by the applicable law,
- A right to limit the processing of your personal data, provided that such request for limitation complies with the requirements of applicable law,
- A right to portability allowing you to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, or to request that such personal data be transmitted to another data controller, provided that such request for portability complies with the requirements of applicable law,
- A right to object to the processing of your personal data on grounds relating to your particular situation, provided that such objection complies with the conditions required by the applicable law,
- The right to withdraw at any time the specific consent given to the collection of your personal data, in particular when the processing of your personal data is used for commercial prospecting purposes,
- The right to define directives relating to the conservation, deletion and communication of your personal data after your death.
